Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Jay Jalaram Ayurvedic Medical College, At-Shivpuri, Post-Kakanpur, Ta.Godhra, Distt. Panchmahals-388713, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0565)** inspection was conducted on **20.03.2025 and 21.03.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity of **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- 2) Further, the MARBISM was also in receipt of a letter from the I/c Registrar, Gujarat Ayurved University enclosing the CoA vide ref no. **Acad/33/2025-26/2552 dated 13.03.2025** wherein affiliation of **Gujarat Ayurved University** has been given to your institute to conduct **UG (BAMS) Course with 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2025-26.**
- 3) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed.**

2. **The I/c Registrar, Gujarat Ayurved University enclosing the CoA vide ref no. Acad/33/2025-26/2552 dated 13.03.2025** wherein affiliation of GAU is given to your institute to conduct **UG (BAMS) Course with 54 seats instead of 60 seats for the academic year 2025-26.**

- 4) The assessment report was placed in the **124th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **29.05.2025** On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 11.06.2025** to appear on **13.06.2025** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the permission to your college with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied.**
- 5) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated in the hearing letter. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter. No. JJAMC/456/2025 dated 12.06.2025** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives **Dr. Siba Prasad, Principal of the college** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **13.06.2025** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. 26/2552 dated 13.03.2025, regarding affiliation of GAU given to conducting UG (BAMS) Course with 54 seats instead of 60 seats for academic year 2025-26, we raised appeal to give permission UG (BAMS) Course with 60 seats under Gujarat Ayurved act- 2021 sec 34 to honorable Gujarat Government, hearing was done on date of 31/05/2025, Government satisfied with the appeal and we are soon going to receive university affiliation for 60 seat in UG (BAMS) intake for the academic year 2025-26, as soon as we will receive university affiliation letter for 60 seat intake, we will immediately submit it to NCISM. No document is submitted by the college in support of appeal filed to honorable Gujarat Government. Hence, **Shortcoming Persists**

- 6) The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms regulations, namely, "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024, and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020, the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 127th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 20.06.2025 and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. However, Gujarat Ayurved University has issued the CoA wherein 54 seats is granted instead of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26. Hence, the Board decided to issue yearly permission with an intake capacity of 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) Course in accordance with regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations, 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

- 7) Therefore, Yearly Permission in accordance with Regulation 54(3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 is hereby granted to Jay Jalaram Ayurvedic Medical College, At-Shivpuri, Post-Kakanpur, Ta.Godhra, Distt. Panchmahals-388713, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0565) with an intake capacity of 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) UG (BAMS) course as per the affiliation issued by Gujarat Ayurved under for the academic session 2025-26 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
- I. Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 54 seats (instead of 60 seats) shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
 - II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 8) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 9) Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical Institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 10) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

- 11) Compliance report of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the implementation letters vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 and 06.09.2024 issued by the board.
- 12) The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 30th November, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - The remaining shortcomings mentioned in Para no. 5 above, shall be fulfilled.
- 13) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
